Together, we have strengthened the foundation's impact, ensuring that compassionate, family-centered hospice care is accessible to all who need it in Aroostook County.

Our vision remains clear: to provide exemplary hospice care in collaboration with Northern Light Home Care & Hospice. The Aroostook House of Comfort is not just a facility; it is a sanctuary of care, powered by a remarkable team of providers, nurses, aides, social workers, chaplaincy, and volunteers. In 2024, we celebrated significant milestones that furthered our mission and strengthened our presence in the community. The 11th Annual Golf Classic was a resounding success, raising over \$80,000 and bringing our cumulative event total to over \$520,000. Our 2nd Annual Walk for Hospice united over 300 attendees and generous sponsors, raising \$60,000 to support our services. These events provided not only crucial financial support but also fostered awareness about the importance of hospice care throughout Aroostook County.

Our Remembrance Way Memorial Garden & Pathway continues to flourish as a serene space for reflection and remembrance. Each stone and bench placed along this pathway tells a story of love and connection, symbolizing the enduring strength of our community. Additionally, our Charity Care Fund, established in 2022, remains a cornerstone of our mission, providing approximately 162 days of patient care at a value exceeding \$50,000.

This year, we were honored to launch a \$75,000 Matching Grant Campaign, made possible by the extraordinary generosity of an anonymous donor. With the help of donors across the community, we achieved this match, raising a total of \$150,000. This incredible accomplishment underscores the power of collective support and ensures the sustainability of our vital programs.

We have also deepened our community presence by collaborating with Northern Light Home Care & Hospice to ensure that both medical professionals and community members better understand the philosophy of hospice care and the resources available. The heartfelt testimonials we receive from families touched by the Aroostook House of Comfort affirm the profound impact of this work. Northern Light Home Care & Hospice, a local Medicare-certified agency, administers hands-on hospice care.
