Additionally, our Charity Care Fund, established in 2022, remains a cornerstone of our mission, providing approximately 162 days of patient care at a value exceeding \$50,000.

This year, we were honored to launch a \$75,000 Matching Grant Campaign, made possible by the extraordinary generosity of an anonymous donor. With the help of donors across the community, we achieved this match, raising a total of \$150,000. This incredible accomplishment underscores the power of collective support and ensures the sustainability of our vital programs.


